16 "(D) to update the strategic plan devel-17 oped under subparagraph (C) not less fre-18 quently than once every 4 years and such that 19 the planning cycle for the updates aligns with 20 the planning cycle for updates to the National 21 Strategy for Advanced Manufacturing required 22 under section 102(c)(4) of the America COM-23 PETES Reauthorization Act of 2010 (42) 24 U.S.C. 6622(c)(4) to better ensure the Pro-25 gram reflects the priorities of the national 26 strategy;".
